[Holden Arboretum](#)



The Holden Arboretum was started in 1931 with a bequest from Albert Fairchild Holden. Built up over the decades by members of the Holden family and other interested parties, Holden Arboretum now encompasses 3,600 with 120,000 plants, with the focus on a recognized collection of trees and shrubs, which are displayed in gardens accompanied by groundcovers and perennials, and in themed collections. The Arboretum has 20 miles of hiking trails, visitor center, reference library and picnic area are on the grounds.

[Lake Metroparks](#)



Lake Metroparks was formed in 1958 under the authority of the Ohio Revised Code and is a separate political subdivision of the state of Ohio. Lake Metroparks provides visitors with countless recreational and educational experiences at diverse facilities spread over 36 parks encompassing 8,196 acres including an agriculturally themed park, a nature center, a state-of-the-art education and wildlife rehabilitation center, two golf courses, more than 50 miles of trails, six parks on Lake Erie's shoreline and a cross-country ski center.

ODNR is the state agency charged with maintaining natural resources such as state parks, public lands, state forests, state waterways, and recreation areas. Its Division of State Parks oversees Headlands State Park, a mile-long, natural sand beach which is the largest in the state.
